## FALL FURNACE MAINTENANCE

- 1. Check thermostat (function, settings, location)
- 2. Check/lubricate furnace fan motor (as applicable)
- 3. Check blower motor amps (as applicable)

- 5. Check contactor (clean as required)
- 6. Inspect condenser fan motor and blades
- 7. Check condenser coil (clean as required)

- 11. Check humidifier damper position (seasonal-summer-closed)
- 12. Check condensate pump/lines (clean as required)

- 17. Inspect service valve
- 18. Clean blower (removal of blower not included)

- 21. Check and advise on performance and air distribution
